...that The Breakfast Program began in 2019 and with the help of 20 volunteers has served over 6,309 breakfasts. Yes...that's over 6,309.

...that our typical patron is a senior citizen 50-85 years old. We also have two young Moms with children who come regularly; and we have attendees from a local social program who come with their social worker.

...that we have a working relationship with the <u>Hungry</u> <u>Lunch</u> in Carleton Place, <u>A Meal for All</u> in Almonte, Service Canada, and members of Town Council including the Mayor.

...that we have hosted presentations on the legal rights of tenants, seniors' fraud, and Service Canada programs for seniors.

...that The Breakfast Program is possible through the work of 20 volunteers giving an annual total of 2,652 volunteer hours to this ministry.

Did You Know...

...that without a Sunday School, St. Jimmy's Table gives children and youth of the church the chance to explore and share their faith with peers. Events also provide an opportunity for parents and grandparents to enjoy a time of fellowship.

...that already the original program transformed from a play group to a larger community gathering and includes a youth program - YLC (Young Leaders' Connection).

...that the children who attend generally range from 3 to 9 years of age, and attend with a parent or grandparent. Additionally, the plan is to expand an already-dedicated core group of youth who are 12 to 18 years of age. There are also individuals who attend the program for the fellowship aspect of events.

...that, on average, there are 30 people present at each event although this somewhat varies between 20 and 50 on occasion.

...that St Jimmy's Table looks forward to widening its community connections and continuing to provide even more faith-filled opportunities for all ages.
